Kings City ~ In this magnificent palace, you'll discover a theme park in the style of the ancient kings offering visitors an amazing trip back in time, including caves, a cruise through King Solomon's Halls, and a wealth of interactive activities.

Swimming with the Dolphins ~ On the shores of the Red Sea, is an ecological site unique in Israel and throughout the world where visitors can enjoy a natural atmosphere, magical views, and secluded beach, together with the unusual opportunity of meeting and observing dolphins in their natural habitat.

Excavational dig ~ Descend into the caves of the former civilization at Maresha, and the adventure begins. Bet Guvrin, south of Beth Shemesh, is just one of these amazing places in Israel. Recently a 1700-year-old menorah was found in the vicinity. Some areas are yet unexcavated but they possibly contain more treasures from the Byzantine era; the most beautiful mosaic floors were brought to the Israel Museum in Jerusalem

Speed Boating ~ At Achziv we will board a jet boat that will take us on a powerful ride alongside the coast. We'll explore some rock caves and see incredible views of Rosh Hanikra from the sea itself. You're sure to get soaked on this ride, but don't worry as soon as were back on land the hot sun will dry you off in no time.

ATVing ~ This ATV course is located in the Horei Yehuda, mountainous outskirts of Yerushalayim. Your adrenaline is sure to spike as you drive along the 1 hour course. But this is no ordinary off road driving, You'll stop on the way to learn about the different vegetation growing in the area. You'll stop to pick some grapes from the vineyards.
